Hello Phoenix Charter Academy Lawrence,

We are writing to inform all students and adult supporters of the extension of school closing to May 1st and reopening on May 4th. As you may have heard, Governor Baker announced yesterday that all Massachusetts schools will remain closed through May 1st. Phoenix Charter Academy Lawrence is taking all precautions to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our community during this difficult time. We are following the recommendations and guidelines provided by the Governor to support the slowdown of the COVID-19 spread. While there are no known cases of COVID-19 in the Phoenix Charter Academy Lawrence community, it is our most important priority to ensure that our students, staff, and their families remain healthy and safe.

During this closure, we will continue to offer remote learning services to all of our students. Teachers, support staff and administrators will continue to prioritize learning from home and support all students and families to achieve academically. We take our responsibility to educate your students very seriously and will do our best to promote learning and safety during this uneasy time.
